Pressing Forward into 2022

- Our goals as the Body of Christ.
- Discipleship Worksheet: Catechism & Memory Passage
- Last week: **1 John 2:3-6.** Blessed are those who walk in the Law of the LORD! (Psalm 119:1-3)
- Did we pray Colossians 1:9-11 for each other? Do we remember Col. 4:12?

Is Doing the Will of God Important? (Matt 7:21-23; James 1:22; 1 Jn 2:17)

What Happens at Rebirth?

- Rebirth ("being born-again" John 3:3-8) is a SUPERNATURAL ACT of God wherein He "re-creates" a sinner, one of His enemies, into a NEW CREATURE. (2 Corinthians 5:17)
- At rebirth, God takes a sinner's heart of stone and replaces it with a NEW heart of flesh. The heart is the center of man's thoughts (mind), emotions, desires, and will. In giving man a new heart God gives man a NEW NATURE. (Ezekiel 36:26; 2 Peter 1:4)
- At rebirth, God gives a sinner HIS SPIRIT to <u>cause</u> this new creation to walk in His statutes, so that they will keep His judgments and DO THEM. (Ezekiel 36:27)
- At rebirth, God adopts a sinner into His family making him/her a child of God and an heir of God. (John 1:12-13; James 1:18; 1 John 3:5-10; Romans 8:15-17; Galatians 4:5; Ephesians 1:5)
- At rebirth, God transforms a person living by their own will into a person who now lives to do God's will. (Psa 42:1-2; 73:25-26; Matt 7:21; 12:50; 1 John 2:17)
- The "natural" response to one being born-again is OBEDIENCE to the commandments of God. (Ezekiel 36:26-27; 1 John 2:3-6; 3:6-10; 5:1-3; John 14:15, 21, 23-24; 15:10, 13-14)

THEREFORE

- Definition: "for that reason"; "accordingly"; "that being the case"
- 15x in Ephesians; 5x in chapter 5.

Our First 'Therefore' (Ephesians 5:1; 4:1; Colossians 1:10)

- Our first "therefore" (5:1) points us back to chapter 4. Paul beseeches US to "walk worthy of our calling." (Ephesians 4:1)
- (5:2) "to walk" gives the idea of **progress** and a **forward direction**.
- (Matthew 11:29-30) We do not walk alone doing our own thing. We are commanded to be YOKED to Christ and learn from Him.
- The Christian walk is one of FOLLOWING Christ. "To follow" as in Luke 9:23 and John 10:27 shows us that we are to "walk just as He walked." (1 John 2:6; John 8:12; 12:26; 21:22; Matt 10:38)
- In the Christian life there is a narrow gate to enter and a difficult, narrow way to *walk* that leads to life. (Matthew 7:13-14; Proverbs 4:25-27)

'Therefore' Be Imitators of God (Ephesians 5:1)

• We are <u>commanded</u> (IMPERATIVE MOOD) to *always* (PRESENT TENSE) "mimic" (imitate; acts like; be like) GOD.

Walk in Love, Just As Christ (Ephesians 5:2)

- The first way to imitate God is to love <u>as</u> Christ has loved us <u>and</u> gave Himself for us AS WE ARE COMMANDED. (John 13:34-35; Galatians 2:20)
 - Biblical love <u>denies</u> self and lives to serve God and others just as Christ! (Matthew 20:28; Luke 9:23; Philip 2:5-8; 1 John 3:16)
 - Biblical love <u>forgives</u> just as we have been forgiven. (Ephesians 4:32; Colossians 1:13)
 - Biblical love loves <u>unconditionally</u>. (1 John 2:12; Isaiah 43:25)
 - Our love for each other is to be <u>fervent</u>; <u>abounding</u> more and more. (1 Peter 4:8; 1 Thess 3:12; 4:9-10; 2 Thess 1:3)
 - ✗ WARNING: If we do not love our brothers and sisters, then we are not born-again! (1 John 3:14-15)

DO NOT Walk as the World (Ephesians 5:3-5)

• WARNINGS: 1 Corinthians 6:9-10; Galatians 5:19-21; Revelation 21:8

DO NOT Be Deceived (Ephesians 5:6)

- Many are being deceived today! We test <u>everything</u> and <u>everyone</u> by the <u>written</u> Word of God. (Matthew 7:21-23; 24:4-5, 11, 24; 1 Thessalonians 5:21; 1 John 4:1; Isaiah 8:20) See Colossians 2:8; 2 Peter 2:1-2.
- The ONLY WAY not to be DECEIVED is to be ABIDING in the WORD. (John 8:31; James 1:25)
- To ABIDE in God's Word means to READ it, MEDITATE on it, MEMORIZE it, STUDY it, and DO it. (See last's week sermon.)

DO NOT Be Partakers with Sons of Disobedience (Eph:7; 1 Cor 15:33)

WALK as Children of Light (Ephesians 5:8-10)

- (v. 8) The verbs are very important!
 - → "you were . . . " PAST TENSE. Something you were but are not now!
 - → "you <u>are</u>..." PRESENT TENSE. Something you NOW <u>are</u>.
- → "walk" PRESENT, ACTIVE, IMPERATIVE.
- ★ "in the Lord" We, as Christians, must constantly remind ourselves that we are "in Christ".
- ☆ Also the missing prepositions (in; of) are important. We were NOT IN DARKNESS but WE WERE DARKNESS ITSELF!! We are NOT IN THE LIGHT but WE ARE LIGHT! (John 8:12; Matthew 5:14-16)
- (v. 9) The fruit of the Spirit (of walking in the light). Light produces fruit; darkness does not.
 - → ALL goodness. Goodness is LOVE in action. See 1 Thessalonians 5:15; 1 John 3:18; Romans 2:6-7; Gal 6:9-10; John 5:28-29.
 - → ALL righteousness. Living (walking) in righteous character before God and man. Doing what is RIGHT in God's eyes. (Rom 6:13; 1 Tim 6:13; 1 John 2:29; 3:6-9; Titus 2:12-14; Acts 10:35; Eccl 12:13-14)
 - → ALL truth. God's Word is TRUTH. Fruit of walking in light is walking in conformity to the <u>written</u> Word of God. (John 17:17; Psalm 119:151-152, 160) See 2 John 4; 3 John 3-4
 - ★ Those who do truth come to the light. Those who love evil stay away from the light. (John 3:20-21)
- (v. 10) We are to live our lives "fully pleasing" (acceptable) to the Lord. (Colossians 1:9-11; Hebrews 13:20-21; 1 Thessalonians 4:1; 2 Timothy 2:3-4; Hebrews 11:5; 1 John 3:22)
- To walk (live) in the light means to walk (live) before God hiding nothing! Knowing He sees everything. (Hebrews 4:13; **1 John 1:6-7**)

DO NOT Fellowship with Darkness (Ephesians 5:11-13)

- (2 Corinthians 6:14) A Christian has NO COMMUNION/FELLOWSHIP with DARKNESS!!
- We are WARNED of the deeds of the flesh:
 - → Do not be partakers. (v. 7; 1 Cor 15:33)
 - \rightarrow Have no fellowship. (v. 11)
 - → Expose it. (v. 11) BY SHINING AS LIGHT! (Matthew 5:14-16)
- LIGHT will naturally expose evil!

Our Last 'THEREFORE' - Walk Circumspectly (Ephesians 5:14-17)

• "circumspectly" means walking carefully, exactly, purposely.

- One walks wisely when they walk (live; do) according to the Word of God; a FOOL ignores the Word of God. (Matthew 7:24-29)
- (v. 16) A wise person knows that life (time, days, hours, minutes) is a gift of God. It is God who gives life and takes life. (Acts 17:25; Job 12:10). Therefore, a wise person "redeems the time" he/she is given. (Ecclesiastes 9:10; Colossians 3:17, 23; Galatians 6:10)
- (v. 16) A wise person walks (lives) circumspectly because he/she knows that the days (times) we live are EVIL. The whole world lies under the influence of the evil/wicked one. (1 John 5:19)
- (v. 16) **BECAUSE the DAYS are EVIL**. Fools do not take danger/evil seriously. A fools says, "It won't happen to me."
- (Matthew 7:24-29) Are you a FOOL or are you WISE? Do you "say" or do you "do"? Change wind, rain, floods to bombs, bullets, famine!

★ THEREFORE ...

- rightarrow (v. 14) WAKE UP! NOW! Idleness leads to so many others sins.
 - ★ (Romans 13:11-14) Let <u>us</u> cast off the works of darkness (laziness, complacency, prayerlessness, disobedience to God's commands, etc.), and let <u>us</u> put on the armor of light. Let <u>us</u> walk properly. Let us walk in the light HIS LIGHT. (John 8:12; 1 John 1:6-7)
 - \star (1 Corinthians 15:34) Awake to righteousness, and do not sin.
 - \star (1 Thess 5:6-8) Let <u>us</u> not sleep, but let <u>us</u> watch and be sober.
- ☆ (v. 17) DO NOT BE FOOLS! USE YOUR MIND!
 - ★ Understand what the will of the Lord is!
 - ★ (Romans 12:1-2) Our minds must be RENEWED by the <u>written</u> Word of God.
 - ★ (Colossians 1:9-11) We pray to be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding, *in order that* we may walk worthy of the Lord, *fully pleasing* Him, being *fruitful* in every *good* work and *increasing* in the knowledge of Him.
 - ★ (Matthew 7:21; 12:50; 1 John 2:17) Those who do the will of God go to heaven, are in the family of God, and live forever.

Pressing Forward into 2022

- ① Pray for each other. (Matthew 6:9-15)
- 2 Walk worthy of our calling. (Ephesians 4:1)
- ③ Imitate God. (Ephesians 5:1)
- ④ Walk in love as Christ has loved us. (Ephesians 5:2; John 13:34-35)
- ⑤ Walk as children of light. (Ephesians 5:8) Showing forth the fruit of all righteousness, all goodness, and all truth. (Eph 5:9; Matt 5:14-16)
- ⁽⁶⁾ Walk knowing that we are living is DANGEROUS times. (Ephesians 5:16)
- Walk wisely, redeeming the time, learning and doing the will of God. (Ephesians 5:15-17)
