

Why Did God Move John to Write This Letter

- John writes as a EYE-WITNESS not only of a person, Jesus Christ, but <u>the</u> life that is promised in and through Christ.
- (1 John 1:3) What John had experienced moved him to share with others.
- (1 John 1:3) <u>This life</u> is experienced in the fellowship (relationship) with God and other Christians, the Body of Christ. (John 17:2-3)
 - ★ Eternal life has two qualities:
 - ① Quantity: It is ETERNAL and can never end. (Philippians 1:6; John 10:27-28)
 - ② Quality: It is a God given life (new creation) that has its own nature. This new life begins the moment one believers. (John 5:24)
- John sets before his readers a series of conditional questions for them to test themselves to see if they truly have been born-again. He uses the word "if" 21 times and the verb "to know" 26 times. Example: 1 John 2:3-6
- (1 John 1:4) John writes that his readers' joy may be FULL (*pleroo*). (John 15:11; 16:24; Luke 2:10; Eph 3:19; Romans 14:17; Philip 4:4; 1 Thess 5:16)
- (1 John 5:13) John writes this letter so that his reader can know of certain that they have eternal life. 1 John is a tool for us to examine ourselves if we really do have eternal life. (2 Corinthians 13:5; 2 Peter 1:10)

Either Or (1 John 2:15)

- EITHER one loves GOD and hates the world <u>or</u> loves the world and does not love God. The world and God are complete opposites. One always disappoints and never satisfies while the other, God, abundantly satisfies. (Psalm 36:7-9; 65:4; Matthew 5:6; John 4:14; 7:37)
- One cannot say, "I love God and I love the things and ways of the world." One cannot serve to masters. You will be loyal to one and not the other. (Matthew 6:24)
- To love the world is <u>enmity</u> with God. A friend of the world is an enemy of God. (James 4:4; Romans 8:7; 1 John 2:15-16)
- Either one lives to please God or to please themselves and men. (Gal 1:10)
- If you live as a Christian the world WILL hate you. (John 15:19; 17:14)

The World Is Dangerously Deceptive (1 John 2:15-17)

- "because the days are evil." (Ephesians 5:15-17)
- The World "lies under the sway of the wicked one" Satan. (1 John 5:19; Ephesians 2:1-3; Revelation 12:9; 20:3) GOVERNMENT
- The Six Axes of Evil used by Satan.
- The WORLD and GOD are

OPPOSITES as LIGHT and DARKNESS.

→ EITHER we are walking in the LIGHT as He is in the light OR we are walking in the DARKNESS (the World). (1 John 1:5-7; 2:9, 11; John 3:19-20)

ACADEMIA

→ EITHER we are a DISCIPLE

of CHRIST, following hard after Him, or we are an ENEMY of GOD in love with the world and its ways! (James 4:4) We are worshipers or idolaters! (Col 3:5; 1 John 5:21)

- The World hates GOD and it hates true disciples of Christ (John 15:18), but loves its own (John 15:19).
- Satan has always been busy in "Christian" work (churches, Bible translation, evangelistic campaigns, Sunday School programs, Bible studies, mission organization, etc.) (2 Corinthians 11:13-15; Matthew 7:21-23; 13:20-22)
- Satan's work of deception was and is in FULL speed since the middle of last century - just as God promised - see 2 Timothy 3:13.
- Satan's tools are:
 - → A Counterfeit Gospel. (Galatians 1:6-9) THERE is only one Gospel ALL others are false. "Christianity" accepts many different ones.

→ Compromise. We are a generation of choices NOT absolutes; preferences NOT truths; comfort NOT growth; experience NOT knowledge; sight NOT faith; me NOT God.

X We are the final judges of righteousness. I am the final authority for what I believe and practice NOT the Word of God.

X The "Church" has been and is following the lead of culture. The "Church" does not deny itself, does not die to self, and is following the world rather than Christ.

- → Tolerance/Relativism. Satan manipulates "the church" into a false interpretation of John 17:20-21. Unity with the Father and the Son can only be achieved in being unified in TRUTH. Satan's counterfeit gospels attempt to unite people through COMPROMISE -TOLERANCE.
- → Materialism. The things of the world rather the things of God. (Colo 3:1-2; Matt 6:19, 24; Luke 16:8-9 (with Colossians 3:5); Philip 3:19)

- → Busyness. (Exodus; Luke 10:42) Living by worldly demands rather than God commanded priorities. A disciple, by definition, has a burning DESIRE to be like his Master, is DETERMINED to be like His Master, is DISCIPLINED in the pursuit of his goal, and is DILIGENT in his pursuit.
- → Complacency: Definition: "a feeling of calm self-satisfaction with one's own abilities or situation that prevents you from trying harder"; "selfsatisfaction especially when accompanied by unawareness of actual dangers or deficiencies."(Zephaniah 1:12) (Hebrews 6:11-12)
- → "Privatization" of religion. Religion is all about ME, my experience, my life, my redemption, my walk, my Lord, my Saviour, etc. (Rom 12:4-5)
- → Laziness. Hebrews 6:11-12; Proverbs 26:16
- → Self-Righteousness. "I don't need the Church"; "I don't need to grow"; "I am better than others"; "I don't need to pray"; etc.

Three Devices of the World System (1 John 5:16)

- lust of flesh taking normal desires and making them sinful.
 - hunger is ok; but gluttony is sinful.
 - thirst is ok; but drunkenness is sinful. (Ephesians 5:18; 1 Peter 4:3; Galatians 5:21; 1 Corinthians 5:11; 6:9-10)
 - sleep is ok; but laziness is sinful. (Matthew 25:26)
 - sex is ok; but only within the limits that God has commanded, anything outside these limits is sinful. (Hebrews 13:4; 1 Corinthians 6:9-10; Galatians 5:19-21; Ephesians 5:5; Revelation 22:15)
 - **DEEDS of the FLESH:** Galatians 5:19-21; Romans 1:24-32; 1 Cor 6:9-10) – Those who practice these will **NOT** inherit the kingdom of God!
 - "the flesh is weak!" (Matthew 26:41)
 - ★ Consider: Romans 7:18; John 6:63; Philippians 3:3; Romans 13:14
- lust of the eyes
 - This device works against our sight and our minds.
 - The eye is the gateway to the mind and body. (Matt 6:23; Luke 11:34)
 - "Turn away your eyes from looking at vanity" (Psalm 119:37)
 - "Guard YOUR heart . . ." (Proverbs 4:23)
 - See Achan's sin in Joshua 7:21.
 - REMEMBER LOT'S WIFE! (Gen 19:17, 26; Luke 17:31-32)
 - Remember the cost David paid for lusting after Bathsheba! (2 Samuel 11:1-5; 12:1-10; Psalm 32; Psalm 51:1-7)
- the pride of life
 - Pride is the "mother" of all sins. Pride holds many in bondage to their sins. (Psalm 10:2-4)
 - God hates pride: Proverbs 6:16-17; 8:13; 16:5
 - First pride then shame. Proverbs 11:2
 - First pride then destruction. Proverbs 16:18
- ★ ALL three were involved in Eve's sin! See Genesis 3:6

The DANGEROUS DRIFT into Worldliness

- Christ warned us that <u>many</u> will hear the gospel, receive it joyfully, and walk away after a time. (Matthew 13:20-22)
- Demas, a companion with Paul on mission trips, walked away because of love of the world. (Colossians 4:14; Philemon 24; **2 Timothy 4:10**)
- We are warned that there will be a GREAT falling way, lawlessness will abound, and the love of many will grow cold! (2 Thess 2:3; Matthew 24:12)
- The WORLD does not tell you to forsake your faith for it, but gradually, seductively, deceitfully, lures you away from your faith into its claws!
 - ① First comes *friendship* with the world. James 4:4 cf. Psalm 1:1-3.
 - The world and Christians are natural enemies! (1 John 3:13)
 - ② Spotted by the world. (James 1:27)
 - When you get close to dirt it leaves its mark on you!
 - ③ Conformity to the world. (Romans 12:2)
 - When there is no longer a difference between a "christian" and an unbeliever.
 - ④ Condemned with the world. (1 Corinthians 11:32)
 - God will discipline His children! (Hebrews 12:6-11)
 - He might even take their life away! (1 Corinthians 11:29-30)
- THE DANGER: 2 Peter 2:18-20

PRESSING FORWARD: DO the WILL of GOD (1 John 5:17)

- Live by the <u>absolutes</u> of God's Word. DO NOT follow the world and the teachings of men! (Matt 15:1-9) FOLLOW CHRIST and teach others to obey ALL that <u>HE</u> commanded! (Luke 4:4; 9:23; Matthew 5:19; 28:20)
 - ★ <u>ALL</u> children of God abide in His Word (John 8:31) and practice righteousness. (1 John 3:9-10)
 - ★ <u>ALL</u> children of God <u>do</u> the will of the Father. (Matt 7:21; 12:50; John 10:27-28; 1 Peter 4:2; 1 John 3:3, 21-24; Eph 5:14-17; Heb 10:36)
 - ★ Do I find my joy and satisfaction in my obedient fellowship with God? (John 14:15, 21-24; 15:10; 1 John 1:6-7)
- **@ BAD COMPANY CORRUPTS!** (1 Corinthians 15:33)
- Take heed that no one deceives you. (Matthew 24:4, 5, 11, 24; Col 2:4, 8)
- A little leaven (compromise) leavens (compromises) the whole bunch. (1 Cor 5:6; Matthew 13:33; Galatians 5:9)
- TEST everything by the WORD of GOD (not by men). (Isaiah 8:20; Acts 17:11; 1 Thessalonians 5:21)
- GUARD your eyes the door to your heart! (Job 31:1; Proverbs 4:23-27; Psalm 101:3; 119:37; Job 31:1; Matthew 5:27-29; 6:23; Luke 11:34)
- Make NO provision for the flesh! (Rom 13:14; 8:12-13; Gal 5:16-17; 1 Peter 2:11)
- **③ PRAY PRAY PRAY PRAY!** (Colossians 4:2; Luke 18:1; Ephesians 3:14-21)
