# Growing as Disciples TOGETHER

- ★ Our goals for 2023:
- Running TOGETHER and not by ourselves.
- Praise and thanksgiving for all that God has done, is doing, and has promised to do for us! (Psalm 109:30; 1 Thessalonians 5:18)
- AIM to please God in everything we do. (2 Corinthians 5:8-10)
- Delighting in the Lord (Psalm 37:4; 119:47; Isaiah 58:14)
- Stewardship of the grace/gifts we have received. (1 Peter 4:10-11)
- Knowing and doing the will of God (Romans 12:1-2; James 1:22; Epheisans 5:15-17; Proverbs 2:1-5; Colossians 1:9-11; 4:20; 1 Peter 4:2)
- "Imitate me as I imitate Christ" (1 Corinthians 11:1; 4:16; Philippians 3:17; 1 Thessalonians 1:6; 2 Thessalonians 3:9; Hebrews 6:12; 13:7)
- ★ Meditating on our Catechism **TOGETHER**.
- ★ Memorizing & Meditating on God's Word **TOGETHER**.

## Having a Plan for 2023

- ☆ NO PLAN means you do not intend to grow in 2023.
  - ★ Just like making a plan is intentional, so too, not making a plan is intentional.
- Refusing to grow is to DESPISE the commands of God. (2 Peter 3:18-; 2 Peter 2:1-2; Colossians 1:9-11; Hebrews 5:13-14)
- Refusing to grow WITH and PART of the Church is to DESPISE God's purpose for HIS Church. (Ephesians 4:12-16)
- ☆ It is IMPOSSIBLE to keep saying that one is a Christian without growing as a part of a LOCAL church - much like a football player without a team.

# **Examining Ourselves** (2 Corinthians 13:5; 2 Peter 1:10)

- Paul commands, by the authority of Christ, that the saints at Corinth continually examine themselves to see if they are in the faith or not. He uses the present tense, active voice, imperative mood for the verb "to examine".
- If we do not obey the **command** to continually examine ourselves we will not repent. "I tell you, . . . unless you repent you will all likewise perish." (Jesus Christ, Luke 13:3, 5)



#### REVIVAL happens when God's people REPENT of THEIR sins!

#### What is Church? (Romans 12:4-5)

- ★ ONE BODY made up of God's special people. (1 Peter 2:9)
- ☆ MANY MEMBERS with special gifts.
- ★ ONE HEAD as a body has one head, the Church has ONE HEAD Jesus Christ, who is Head over all.
- ☆ The Body takes its directions from ONE HEAD her MASTER...

#### What does the New Testament call the Church?

- He calls His Church CHURCH! Literally, "called out ones".
- He calls His Church His Sheep. (John 10:11, 14-15, 26-29)
- He calls His Church A Body (1 Corinthians 12:12-27)
- He calls His Church His Temple/House (2 Cor 6:16; Eph 2:22; 1 Peter 2:5)
- He calls His Church Household of Faith (Galatians 6:10)
- He calls His Church A Royal Priesthood (1 Peter 2:9)
- He calls His Church A Holy Nation (1 Peter 2:9)
- He calls His Church His Own Special (**Peculiar**) People (1 Peter 2:9; Deut. 4:20; 7:6; Titus 2:14)
- He calls His Church A Chosen (elite; picked out) Generation
- He calls His Church His Elect (Matthew 24:22, 24, 31; Romans 8:33; 9:11; Colossians 3:12; 1 Thess 1:4; Titus 1:1)
- He calls His Church Saints (Rom. 1:7; 2 Cor 1:1; Eph 1:1; Philip 1:1)
- He calls His Church Brothers (Colossians 1:2; Hebrews 2:12, 17)
- He calls His Church Disciples (Acts 6:1-2; 18:23; 20:7)
- He calls His Church His Family (Hebrews 3:6; John 1:12-13; 3:3-8; James 1:18; 1 John 3:1, 2, 10; 5:1-3; Matthew 12:50)
- He calls His Church the Pillar and Ground of TRUTH. (1 Tim 3:15)
- He calls His Church Living stones being built up (1 Peter 2:5)
- He calls His Church the Bride of Christ (Ephesians 5:25-27, 30-33)

# **BEING**

# One Body; Many Members with Responsibilities (Rom 12:1-21)

- (vv. 1-2) Offering Our Bodies as Living Sacrifices our reasonable service.
- (vv. 1-2) Commanded not to be conformed to the world.
- (vv. 1-2) Commanded to be transformed.
- (v. 3) Have a right opinion of yourself. Jesus Others Yourself!
- (vv. 4-5) **ONE** body with **MANY** members.
  - ☆ A body does **EVERYTHING TOGETHER**. If you are not doing what the body is doing you are NOT part of the body.
  - ★ By GOD's design His Churches grow by doing everything **TOGETHER**.

- ☆ Consider the first church (Acts 2:42-47)
  - ✓ (v. 42) They continued steadfastly in DOCTRINE.
  - ✓ (v. 42) They continued steadfastly in FELLOWSHIP.
  - ✓ (v. 42) They continued steadfastly in BREAKING BREAD.
  - ✓ (v. 42) They continued steadfastly in PRAYERS.
  - ✓ (v. 46) They continued daily with ONE ACCORD.
  - ✓ (v. 47) **They worshiped** TOGETHER.
- ★ What was the consequences of **BEING** CHURCH:
  - ✓ (v. 43) They experienced the SUPERNATURAL.
  - ✓ (vv. 44-45) They cared for (loved) each other.
  - ✓ (v. 47) The Lord added to the church daily!
- (vv. 6-8) Being good stewards of the grace and gifts we were given. (1 Peter 4:10-11; Matthew 25:14-30)
  - Every Christian is perfectly gifted by God to serve God's purpose.

 No two Christians are gifted in the same way. Each gift is tailored by God to fulfill God's purpose.

- Diversity in gifts but not doctrine.



- God perfectly gifts His children to fit perfectly into the body that He has put them. (1 Peter 4:10)
- God gifts His children so that their gifts serve others within the Body. (1 Corinthians 12:7, 11)
- God gifts His children so that they will be equipped to do the <u>works</u> that He saved them unto. (Ephesians 2:10)
- God sovereignly gives gifts. A Christian cannot gift themselves.
- Responsibilities of each member of the Body:
  - 1. (v. 9) Love without hypocrisy.
    - 1 Corinthians 13:4-8
    - **❤** Love **is** PATIENT.
    - ◆ Love is KIND.
    - Love does not ENVY.
    - Love does not BOAST.
    - Love is not PROUD.
    - Love is not RUDE.
    - ◆ Love is not SELF-SEEKING.
    - ◆ Love is not PROVOKED (to anger).
    - ► Love THINKS NO EVIL. (does not keep records)
    - ◆ Love does not REJOICE in sin.
    - ◆ Love REJOICES in TRUTH.
    - Love **BEARS** all things.
    - **♥** Love **always** TRUSTS.
    - Love always HOPES.



#### Love always PERSEVERES (never fails; never gives up; never says, "I cannot anymore . . .")

- 2. (v. 9) Abhor evil "to hate"; "have a horror of"
- 3. (v. 9) Cling to what is good "to glue"; "to cement together"
- (v. 10) Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly kindness a natural love for Christians - 1 John 5:1
- 5. (v. 10) In honor giving preference to one another = to honor others above one self. Be a slave to each other. (Matt 20:26; 1 Peter 5:5)
- 6. (v. 11) Not lagging in diligence "constant and earnest effort to accomplish what must be done"
- 7. (v. 11) Be fervent in spirit "to boil with heat" zealous
- 8. (v. 11) Serve the Lord "to be a slave" a slave does the will of the Master. (Hebrews 12:28; 1 Thess 1:9-10)
- 9. (v. 12) Rejoice in hope our hope is in God's promises which are all "Amen" in Christ. (Romans 5:2-3; 2 Corinthians 1:20)
- 10. (v. 12) Patience/Endurance in Tribulation "The characteristic of a man who is not swerved from his deliberate purpose and his loyalty to faith and piety by even the greatest trials and sufferings." (Romans 5:3-4; 8:25; Colossians 1:11)
- 11. (v. 12) Continue Steadfastly in Prayer together See Colossians 4:12
- 12. (v. 13) Distributing to the needs of the saints we are stewards of everything given to us! (1 John 3:17-18; 2 Cor 8:1-4; Gal 6:10)
- 13. (v. 13) Be given to hospitality "pursuing the love of strangers" (Heb 13:2)
- 14. (v. 14) Bless those who persecute you Present, Active, Imperative
- 15. (v. 14) Bless and do not curse them (Matt 5:44; Luke 6:28)
- 16. (v. 15) Rejoice with those who rejoice continually. (1 Cor 12:26)
- 17. (v. 15) Weep with those who weep. (1 Cor 12:26; Hebrews 13:3)
- 18. (v. 16) Be of the same mind toward one another- 1 Cor 1:10; Rom 15:5-6; 16:17; 2 Cor 13:11; Ephesians 4:3; Philippians 2:1-2; 3:16
- 19. (v. 16) Do not be high minded; associate with the humble.
- 20. (v. 20) Do not be wise in your own eyes Proverbs 3:5-7 God created us to be totally dependent on Him for everything.
- 21. (v. 17) Repay no one evil for evil (1 Thess 5:15; 1 Peter 3:8-9)
- 22. (v. 17) Respect what is right always do what is right, good, and honorable.
- 23. (v. 18) Live in peace with everyone pursue peace forgive, settle differences quickly, do not hold grudges. (Hebrews 12:14)
- 24. (v. 19) Do not avenge yourself "not" = strongest negative. "Vengeance is MINE," says God. (Deut 32:35; Hebrews 10:30)
- 25. Overcome evil with good Proverbs 25:21-22; Matt 5:44
