Passage: Psalms 23

Understanding Our Times

- (Matthew 28:18-20) The Great Commission given to the <u>church</u> by Christ was to go out into the world and make <u>DISCIPLES</u>, baptizing only <u>DISCIPLES</u>, and teaching <u>DISCIPLES</u> to do/obey <u>all</u> that Christ has <u>commanded</u>.
- All CHRISTIANS are DISCIPLES of Christ (no exceptions).
 - ➤ A disciple by definition is a **serious student** of God's Word.
 - ➤ A disciple's goal is to be *just like* his Master. (1 John 2:6; 1 Peter 2:21; John 13:1-15; 1 Corinthians 11:1; Ephesians 5:1-2)
 - ➤ God <u>predestinated</u> that all those whom He chose to be His special people be conformed into the image of Christ. God predestinated and God does Romans 8:29-30; 2 Corinthians 3:18 (note: "being transformed . . . by the Spirit of the Lord.")
 - ➤ A disciple accepts his responsibility to be growing as disciple. See Philippians 2:12-13.
 - → God uses His Word to continually sanctify His people. (John 17:17; Psalm 119:160)
 - ➤ A disciple may listen to others but in the end his Master's word must be obeyed. His Master, not others, is TRUTH and His words are TRUTH. (John 14:6)
 - ➤ A disciple reads, studies, meditates (Psalm 1:1-3), memorizes God's Word.
 - ➤ Only those who continue (abiding) in their Master's word are truth disciples. (John 8:31)
 - ➤ Disciples work/study to have God's Word <u>abide</u> in them. (Colossians 3:16; John 15:7; 1 John 2:14; Psalm 1:1-3)
 - ➤ All Christians are disciples but all disciples are not Christians. (John 6:66; Matthew 13:20-22; 7:21-23; 24:4-5, 11,24; 2 Thessalonians 2:3)

- **X** MANY today believe that one can be a Christian without being a serious student of God's Word.
- ➤ Those who are not serious students of God's Word are putting their trust in their own opinions and/or the opinions of others. (Galatians 1:6-9; Psalm 118:8-9; 146:3-5; Jeremiah 17:5-9; Matthew 15:1-9)
- ➤ Christian disciples <u>live</u> their lives on <u>every</u> Word of <u>God</u>. (Luke 4:4) IN ORDER TO LIVE ON EVERY WORD ONE MUST KNOW IT!
- Disciples of the 21st Century will be held to a greater accountability than those of the 1st, 8th, 13th, 17th, 18th, 20th Centuries. (Luke 12:48; Matthew 11:20-24) **MANY DO NOT BELIEVE GOD ABOUT THIS!**
 - ➤ Tools given to us that 1st Century saints did not have:
 - → Our <u>own</u> Bible translated in a language that we can understand.
 - → Commentaries, lexicons, dictionaries, atlases, concordance, cross-references, etc.
 - → Computers, Smart pads, smart phones.
 - → The internet and all that is on it!
 - → Bible study tools:

 - ➤ Biblehub.com
 - ➤ BlueLetterBible.org

- ALL Christians will stand before Christ and give an account for their use of the tools and gifts given to them by God. (2 Corinthians 5:9-10; Ecclesiastes 12:13-14; Hebrews 4:13; LUKE 12:34-36)
- Every Christian's <u>work</u> will be tested and Christ will give to each according to one's work. (Matthew 16:27; John 5:28-29; Romans 2:6-11; Revelation 2:23; 22:12; 1 Corinthians 3:3:11-15)
- ★ Christ declared that there is absolutely **nothing** more important than being a student/disciple of God's Word. (Luke 10:38-)
- **X** MANY today believe that there are more important things to do than serious Bible study.

USING DISCIPLE SKILLS

Psalm 23

(v. 1) "The LORD is my shepherd"

- ➤ "The LORD"
 - → "LORD" "YAHWEH" God's covenant name with His people.
 - His people are chosen by Him. (Romans 8:28-30; 1 Peter 2:9;
 Ephesians 1:3-4)
 - God calls His people. (Romans 8:28-30; Jude 1; 1 Thessalonians 2:12; 2 Thessalonians 2:13-14; 2 Timothy 1:9; 1 Peter 2:9)
 - God draws (drags) His people to Christ. (John 6:44)
 - God sanctifies His people. (Jude 1; John 17:17; Romans 15:16;
 1 Corinthians 1:2; 6:11; 1 Thessalonians 5:23; 2 Thess 2:13;
 2 Timothy 2:21; Hebrews 2:11; 10:29; 1 Peter 1:2)
 - ★ "sanctified" To be separated **by** God **for** God's purposes.
 - His people are given to Christ therefore, <u>preserved</u> in Christ.
 (Jude 1; John 6:39; 10:28-30; 17:11-12, 15; 2 Timothy 4:18; 1 Peter 1:5)
- ➤ "is" ALL the verbs are in the PRESENT TENSE!
- ➤ "my shepherd"
 - ★ "shepherd" not a noun but a verb a participle literally, "is shepherding me"
 - "to shepherd" to guide, feed, shelter, protect, guard, care for, etc.
 - → David understood what is meant to be a shepherd of sheep!
 - He understood the needs of sheep.
 - He understood that sheep, by nature, were weak, defenseless, and foolish.
 - → In stating that the LORD is his shepherd a disciple acknowledges:
 - ① He is a sheep see Psalm 119:176; Isaiah 53:6; Luke 15:3-7; 1 Peter 2:25.
 - ② He **belongs** to the Shepherd hence the pronoun "my".
 - ★ "MY" provider, preserver, watcher, defender, director, everything!
 - ★ A sheep is an object of *property* not a wild animal. Consider 1 Corinthians 6:19-20 - NOTE the pronoun "you" - "ye" in KJV.

- → Either one is a sheep or he is a goat or a wolf!
- ★ Christ is OUR Shepherd:
 - → He is the GOOD Shepherd John 10:11, 14-16
 - A shepherd KNOWS His sheep by name! John 10:3; John 10:27; 2 Timothy 2:19.
 - The good Shepherd lays down His life for His sheep. (1 Samuel 17:34-36)
 - See John 10:11 with Zechariah 13:7; Matthew 26:31; Isaiah 53:10.
 - → He is the CHIEF Shepherd 1 Peter 5:4
 - → He is the **GREAT** Shepherd Hebrews 13:20
 - → He is **OUR** Shepherd those who have been given to Him by the Father. (John 10:27-29)
- ★ Elders are under-shepherds of **God's** sheep. (**Acts 20:28**; 1 Peter 5:2-4; **John 20:15-17**) Elders will give an account of their shepherding at the Judgment Seat of Christ. (Hebrews 13:17; 2 Corinthians 5:9-10)
- ➤ (John 10:27-30) ALL (not some) of Christ's sheep:
 - ① Hear Christ's voice calling them by their name. (John 10:)
 - ② Christ **knows** His sheep. (2 Timothy 2:19)
 - 3 They **follow** Christ. Christ goes before His sheep.
 - 4 Christ gives **them** eternal life. (John 17:2-3)
 - ⑤ Christ watches over/preserves His sheep they shall never perish. (Jude 1, 24; John 3:15; 6:37, 39-40; 17:12; Philippians 1:6; Hebrews 7:25)
 - 6 No ONE/THING can snatch **them** out of Christ's hand.
- ➤ "I shall not want"
 - → Verb: Qal (active voice); Imperfect (an action which is incomplete) possible "I shall never want."
 - → Psalm 34:9-10; 84:11
 - ★ (2 Corinthians 12:1-10) "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness."

He Leads Me (Psalm 23:2-3)

- Four characteristic of OUR SHEPHERD:
 - ① (v. 2) "He makes me to lie down in green pastures"





- ➤ A sheep TRUSTS his Shepherd to provide for him.
- ➤ See Matthew 6:25-33.
- ② (v. 2) "He leads me beside the still waters."
 - ➤ The verb is in the PRESENT TENSE.
 - ➤ Our Shepherd tells us, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink." (John 7:37)
- ③ (v. 3) "He restores my soul."
 - ➤ When one of His strays away He will draw them back.
 - ➤ He will lose NOT ONE.
 - ➤ He will rejoice when HE brings one back. (Matthew 18:12-13: Luke 15:4-7: Psalm 119:176)
 - ➤ Read 1 Peter 2:25 the verb "to return" is in the PASSIVE VOICE.
 - ★ Christ is OUR SHEPHERD and OUR OVERSEERER of your soul! He will lose NOT ONE!
- ④ (v. 4) "He leads me in paths of righteousness."
 - ➤ These are paths of obedience, truth, and holiness.
 - ➤ "leads" gently leads; he does not drive He speaks and His sheep follow.
 - ➤ "paths" "well worn paths" read Jeremiah 6:16; consider Ephesians 4:14; Hebrews 13:9.

★ HE SHEPHERDS HIS SHEEP FOR HIS NAME SAKE and HIS GLORY!

(Psalm 25:11; 31:3; 106:8; Isaiah 43:25; 48:9; Ezekiel 36:22-32)
